A staffing shortage with over 70 PT vacant positions has led to unprecedented mandates beyond contractual limits. PTs are being denied their two 15-minute breaks and are asked to violate patient safety policy by combining required clinical rounds with staggered safety rounds. All the while, management has refused to offer support to its over-worked staffed.
